Section Two
SECONDAPY CURRICULUM COUNCIL

- A. The Board shall establish
 a Secondary Curriculum Council
 made up of the Assistant Superintendent for Instruction, two
 secondary principals and one
 elected representative from
 the following departments:
 Science, Math, English,
 Industrial Arts, ine Arts,
 Language Arts, Guidance and
 Counseling, Physical Education,
 Business Education, Social
 Studies and Special Education
 Services.
- B. The Superintendent of Schools and the Secondary Vice-President of the FFT shall be ex officio (no vote) members of the council.
- C. The purpose of the council shall be to promote continuity in the development and appraisal of the instructional program. It shall:
 - serve as a coordinating and collecting agency for proposed curriculum changes;
 - establish priorities for review and study;
 - 3. make recommendations to the Superintendent and Board of Education.
- D. The Board shall provide five (5) days of release time per year for the Curriculum Council to hold meetings during the normal school day. Specific meetings times will be established by the council. The council may schedule additional meetings outside of normal teaching hours.
