No. of days of disorder:

9 days (July 23 to July 31, 1967);

Curfew restrictions lifted and Police Department returned to normal tours of duty on 10th day.

4 law officers

(1 patrolman, 2 firemen and

1 guardsman)

39 civilians (32 Negro and 7 White)

Persons Injured:

143 law officers (police, fire & guardsmen)

181 civilians

No. of Fires:

727 fires affecting 1682 buildings.

211 buildings completely destroyed or damaged beyond repair -114 buildings require major rehabilitation

Persons Arrested:

703 juveniles detained

6,528 (5747 Negro and 781 White)

Estimated Property Damage:

There is no reliable estimate of property damage resulting from the riot. State Insurance Commissioner Dykhouse has estimated that losses in the riot areas alone were \$144 million, of which \$84 million was insured and \$60 million was uninsured.

Others -- including magazine and newspaper writers -- have estimated total loss as a result of the riot may run as high as \$500 million for the entire city, counting lost sales and wages.

Riot Cost - City of Detroit Government:

\$3, 100,000 extra personnel costs - overtime, Police, Fire and others

1,700,000 damage and loss of city property and additional operating expense

2,400,000 revenue losses

\$7,200,000 total estimated cost
